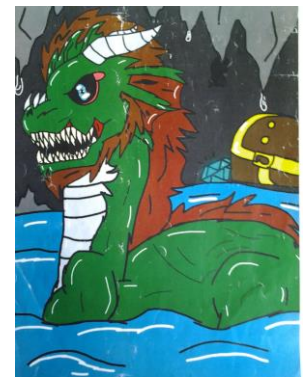
The Queen at 90
