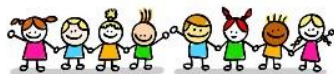
#### FOOTBALL NEWS

## Pit Stop Summer Holiday Club

Some parents have requested that we run Pit Stop child care club during the school holidays. Please see proposed details below and register your interest with the school office before Friday 15<sup>th</sup> June. If there is enough interest, we will run the club throughout the Summer holidays, this year.

### Proposed Activities

Holiday Club would provide a range of free flow activities such as football, craft, paints, games and computers. Planned activities led by an adult include woodland fun, football, cricket, bench ball etc. Theme days would also be run such as detectives, sports, baking and picnics. Activities may be run by Doncaster Rovers and Cre8ive Dance – these may be charged separately. We would also hope to arrange visits, e.g. to the ice-cream parlour in Thorne – again these would be charged separately.

Breakfast would be served at 8am-9am, and will include cereals, toast, fruit, yoghurts, hot drinks and juice. Lunch would be provided by parent/carers with an afternoon snack being provided at 3.15pm and will consist of a variety of savouries such as sandwiches, toast, spaghetti, bagels, pitas, wraps, beans, soup etc. and fruit. Water, breadsticks and other small snacks would be freely available throughout the session.

Staff will be qualified in childcare, first aid, child protection, food hygiene.
