- Facebook 2.8 billion monthly active users (MAUs); now less popular with younger people but still
 the biggest social media platform. \$6 billion profit June to Sept 2019. Recently fined £500,000 for
 their part in the Cambridge Analytica data breach, though they still deny their knowledge of this.
- Instagram Second most popular social media site; recently has banned images depicting self harm following investigation instigated by the suicide of Molly Russell age 14 (2017)
- 3. Tik Tok (formerly Musical.ly) video & live streaming site especially favoured by young girls, who post footage of themselves singing, dancing, lip-synching to pop songs etc. With 500 million MAUs, it was the world's most downloaded app in the first quarter of 2018, beating Facebook & Instagram. Musical.ly was closed down due to the level of online grooming taking place via the site, though has been re-launched with very similar features.
- 4. Messenger linked to Facebook, private message add-on (though can be used without being logged in to FB). Ability to create group chats and "secret conversations" for those concerned about security (sites such as Whatsapp & Snapchat are encypted and so are now more popular).
- 5. Snapchat hugely popular chat & photo site, mainly used for instant pictures which have a range of filtering options. Photos & chats disappear unless purposely saved by the recipient
- Youtube 1 billion hours of Youtube video watched daily. Owned by Google, generated \$15 billion in advertising in 2018. Hugely popular with young children.
- 7. Kik Anonymous chat, only need a phone number or email to create account, not verified. Children often encouraged by predators to communicate on Kik as chats aren't traceable. Recently rumoured to be closing down, but has been sold to another company who are to continue the site. Kin soon to be launched, a crypto-currency which can be bought & sold for real money.
- 8. Likee a new-ish app, similar to Tik Tok but with no age restriction. No facility to report live stream if inappropriate. Has "XPs" (experience points) earned by how much the app is used.
- Azar a new-ish video chat app, to connect to people around the world. App offers instant voice translation into any language & "gems", its in-app currency can be used to unlock filters so they can pick chat partners by region and gender.
- 10. Telegram being used to organise Hong Kong protests. "Military grade security" on personal phones to avoid detection; guarantees anonymity & encryption to link people across the world. A timer can be set for messages to self destruct.
