

So what has been happening in the bubbles?


This week in Nursery they have read the story of Oliver's Milkshake. They discussed how to stay healthy and they are going to make their own milkshakes. They have spent time each day practising their phonics and learning their numbers.




In Mrs Heneghan's bubble the children have been counting and learning to read, write and order their numbers up to 20. Each day they have been doing phonics, learning their tricky words and digraphs for phase 4. The children have also been practicing joined up hand writing. They have had a super time looking at Mr Potato Head from Toy Story and making their own Mr Potato Head with eyes that move!



In Miss Brumwell's bubble they have been reading stories of Supertato by Sue Hendra. The children have designed their own Supertato and written sentences about him. They have used potatoes and decorated them, adding capes, masks and a super hero belt. The children loved this!



In the Year 1 bubbles this week they have welcomed Miss Powell back. The children have been doing work about The Lighthouse Keeper's Lunch and particularly enjoyed inventing their own sandwich to stop the pesky seagulls eating Mr Grinling's lunch. They have designed their own lighthouse which we hope to make over the next couple of days. The children have also been comparing seaside holidays now with those from the past. In Maths they have been working hard, learning to do division.



This week in Miss Lambert's and Miss Richardson's bubbles they have been reading James and the Giant Peach and completing work based around this. Maths has been focusing on problem solving skills- the children have enjoyed the challenge! They have also been completing work outside and in Jenny's Wood.




