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This week the pupils have been learning about the importance of cleaning their teeth. They have read the story of 'How to brush your teeth with Snappy Croc.' In maths, Nursery have been identifying green

objects and sorting them into groups. This week in Reception, we have been learning about pattern in

maths. In English, we have continued our story 'Here we are' and completed lots of activities finding and writing initial sounds. In curriculum, we had a special visit from Susan Durant and learned all about



her role as the mayor. We really enjoyed asking her lots of questions. Well done Early Years for another super week!



This week Year 1 have been reading more of "The Day the Crayons Quit" and have been writing down adjectives to describe some of the crayons. In science we learnt about

Helen Keller and how she overcame her sensory impairments to help others. We then had the privilege of meeting Dawn and her guide dog Millie

and got to ask them lots of questions about how dogs train to become guide dogs and how they can help people who cannot see.



This week in Year 2 we have continued to explore our new book "Spinderella". We used our senses to describe the setting and created some extended noun phrases. In our maths sessions we have been



counting forwards and backwards in 2's, 3's, 5's and

10's. We looked at the different patterns.

we could see when counting and answered reasoning questions about these. In geography we learnt about the compass and human and physical features on a map labelling these and sorting them in to a table. Science this week has involved us learning about the circulatory system and labelling a diagram of the heart. We enjoyed creating pictures in the style of Paul Klee using geometric shapes to create houses. Another super week in Year 2, well done everyone.

This week Year 3-4 have been working on their independent piece of writing regarding the digestive system which has yielded some fantastic pieces of work which the children should be really proud of!



To go along with this hard work the children are continuing their work on place value with the Year 4's even moving onto the tricky roman numerals which they have shown real determination in getting right. We have continued to have an amazing week in all our wider curriculum subjects and are working hard going into our final week.



This week, UKS2 have continued their learning all about the British Empire and have studied some battles that took place

during the Seven Year War. They have also developed their understanding of remixing and looping in music. They have all practised creating their own loops using the devices. This links with our computing lessons and how music can be created digitally.






