We have had yet another busy week in Year 2. This week, we have been studying money in maths. We made amounts in different ways, made total amounts and found change. This week in Year 3 and 4 we have been learning all about Modern Europe. We are now experts at understanding the physical geographical features of locations in Europe, as well as the human. We have loved exploring our continent and the places we live in. This week in maths, Year 4 have been working really hard on time and telling the time- we hope our parents and carers can help us practise over the holidays to consolidate our learning. Year 3 have been learning about fractions and using our problem-solving skills to solve word problems. We hope everyone stays safe over the half term and has a much-needed rest.

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This week, in USK2, we have written gothic horror narratives. We have used some fantastic adjectives and writing devices to make these as descriptive as possible. We have given clues about the characters and setting to add mystery and build suspense.
