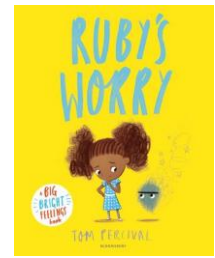

This week, Reception have been learning about matching in their Maths lessons. We have been looking at the same and different types of items such as socks, cars, buttons and Numicon! We have also been reading the story Ruby's Worries and learning to identify what worries we might have and who we can talk to about them. In Phonics, we have been busy learning new phonemes i n m d. We have practised saying the sounds and writing them too. Well done Reception for an excellent week!



This week in Year 1, the children have started on phase 5 in Phonics, exploring the ay, ou, ie and ea sounds. The children have tried really hard to use these sounds, remembering robot arms and blending hands. In Literacy, the children have continued with their instructional writing with a focus on how to make a jam sandwich. The children have had to think about sequencing and the use of imperative verbs. In Maths, the children have completed the place value unit of work and are moving onto addition and subtraction. Each week, the confidence and independence of both classes are growing!





Year 2 have had a great week. We have been learning more about maps and



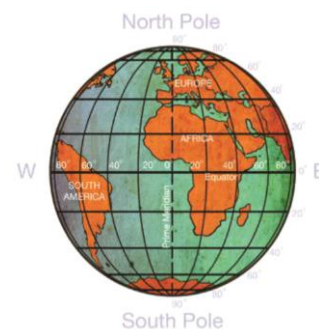
and the difference between human and physical features. We really enjoyed finding our school on a map and we recognised other places on a map of Moorends. In Science, we have been learning more about the human body and the important role our blood has in keeping us alive. We have been working really hard on our descriptions of Mr Twit and have included some amazing adjectives in our writing!

In UKS2 we have continued to learn about writing persuasive letters and balanced arguments. We have enjoyed trying to persuade Mrs Thompson to let us plan a school trip. In Maths we are revising negative numbers and place value. We are now finding out about the Modernist style in Art lessons. We all designed our own Modernist style chairs - we are not sure whether they would be very comfortable! Our knowledge and understanding of world maps is also developing as we learn about coordinates and lines of latitude and longitude.



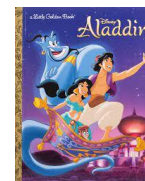
This week the children in Year 3/4 have continued to work hard. They are thoroughly enjoying their Monday drama
