This is regardless of any changes in your circumstances and means you do not need to tell us if your circumstances change. You may also be eligible for school holiday supermarket vouchers and uniform vouchers. Visit:

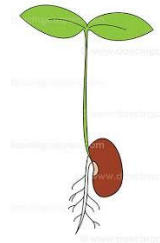

character. In Reception, we have started to look at health and social care jobs within the NHS. We will be continuing to learn about different careers this term.

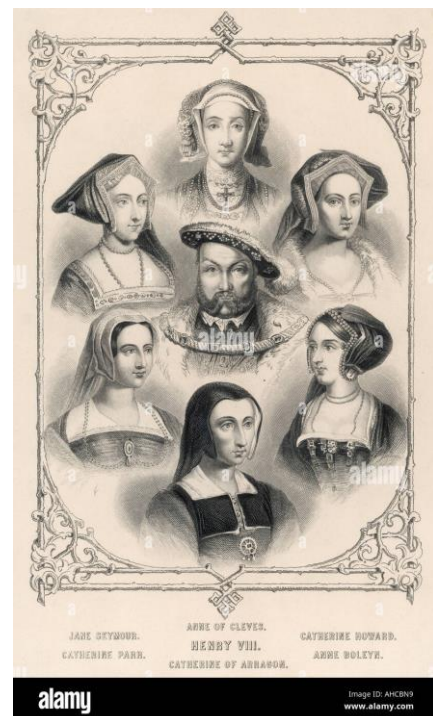


This week Year 2 have been working really hard doing their assessments in English, Maths and Science. We were all really excited for World Book Day and the children and staff enjoyed dressing up as their favourite characters. We have continued to learn about the Terrible Tudors this week. The children loved learning about Henry VIII and his six wives. Well done year 2, Great Effort!



This week Year 1 have continued to explore the text 'The Queen's Hat' and have started writing their own narrative based on this. The children have continued to practise

joining their handwriting and making their letters really clear. It has been assessment week in Maths so the children have been showing everything they know about number and place value using concrete manipulatives. In Art, the children have started focusing on Vincent Van Gogh and have looked at his style of painting.







In LKS2 the children have worked extremely hard during assessment week this week, showing resilience and determination. On an afternoon they have enjoyed continuing with their Anglo Saxon art. The children needed to create an interlocking pattern just like on the metal shoulder clasps discovered at Sutton Hoo. In PE they have continued with their dance unit of learning and have having lots of fun with this!



This week, in UKS2, we have continued learning about The Victorians and how industrialisation lead to urbanisation. We discussed what life would have been like as a poor person living in the slums. We have been really busy with our assessments this week and we are looking forward to seeing the progress we have all made. On Thursday we dressed up as our favourite book characters for World Book Day and talked about our favourite books. Have a lovely weekend.

Are you entitled?

Are you entitled to a £100 uniform voucher?

Am I entitled to free school meals for my child?

**Your child will be eligible for free school meals (FSM) if you are receiving one of the following benefits or support:**

- Universal Credit - Your annual net earned income must be no more than £7,400, as assessed by earnings from up to 3 of your most recent assessment periods.
- Income Support.
- Income-based Jobseeker's Allowance.
- Income-related ESA.
- Child Tax Credit but not Working Tax Credit and your annual income is below £16,190.
- Guarantee element of State Pension Credit.
- Support under part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999.
- Parents receiving Working Tax Credit for four weeks after their employment finishes are entitled to free school meals during that period. This also applies to parents who start working less than 16 hours per week.

**You are NOT entitled to free school meals if:**

- You receive Working Tax Credit except where the 'four week run-on' applies.

Even if your child is in Reception to Year 2 and they already receive a free meal under the government's Universal Infant Free School Meal (UIFSM) system, it is still worth applying for FSM. Benefits of successful FSM applications are:

- A £100 uniform voucher (payable on your first successful application only).
- Free school milk up to the end of Year 2.
- Reduced costs for residential visits.
- Other benefits may become available from time to time.

**If your child becomes eligible for Free School Meals before 31 March 2022, they will continue to be eligible until they leave Primary Education.** This is regardless of any changes in your circumstances and means you do not need to tell us if your circumstances change.
