In **Nursery** this week we have been learning about farmers growing crops, how food grows in different places around the world and how food is harvested. We are also getting ready to plant some of our own vegetables out in our planters in the outdoor area. The children really enjoyed trying some new fruits and vegetables such as kiwi, pineapple, plums, peppers and tomatoes and all of tried at least one new food. In maths we have been learning about height and thinking about objects which are tall and short, we checked on our beanstalks and looked at whose has grown the tallest so far. A great week in nursery well done everyone!

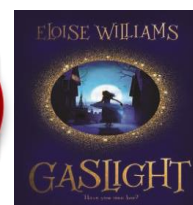
In **Reception**, we have been creating a story map of the traditional tale 'Jack and the Beanstalk' using actions to help us remember the key events! We also have continued to learn about different careers within the NHS and learnt about the roles of a Speech Therapist and Healthcare Scientist. Brilliant work Reception!



This week in **Year 1**, the children have continued to read their class novel, Clean Up! This has linked to the science learning on pollution. The children have really enjoyed learning about air, land and sea pollution and how pollution affects our world. In Art, the children have continued to develop their Van Gogh painting, adding detail to the mountain scene using small brushstrokes.

There are some really creative artists in Year 1! Keep this up!

This week in **lower KS2** the children have been completing their newspaper reports about the stolen egg, we can't wait to read them! In maths we have been finishing and consolidating fractions, ready to move on to a new component next week. The Year 4 children have had the most spectacular experience on their first overnight residential. They were all perfectly behaved and represented West Road well. They enjoyed all of their activities including den building, orienteering and other team building activities.



This week, in **UKS2**, we have continued learning about forces in science, we conducted an investigation to see how surface area effects the time taken for an object to sink. In English we have started our new novel, Gaslight by Eloise Williams, set in Wales during the Victorian era. We compared what we have read so far to one of our previous novels Oliver Twist. Class 10 learnt and practiced some essential life saving skills in swimming, we now all know what to do if we fell in the water or how we could help our friends to safety.

Adam, one of our PE coaches, had his last session with us this week, it was sad to see him go but wish him good luck with his new position and we look forward to Dom working with us.

Are you entitled?

Are you entitled to a £100 uniform voucher?

Am I entitled to free school meals for my child?

Your child will be eligible for free school meals (FSM) if you are receiving one of the following benefits or support:

- Universal Credit - Your annual net earned income must be no more than £7,400, as assessed by earnings from up to 3 of your most recent assessment periods.
- Income Support.
- Income-based Jobseeker's Allowance.
- Income-related ESA.
- Child Tax Credit but not Working Tax Credit and your annual income is below £16,190.
- Guarantee element of State Pension Credit.
- Support under part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999.
- Parents receiving Working Tax Credit for four weeks after their employment finishes are entitled to free school meals during that period. This also applies to parents who start working less than 16 hours per week.

You are NOT entitled to free school meals if:

- You receive Working Tax Credit except where the 'four week run-on' applies.

Even if your child is in Reception to Year 2 and they already receive a free meal under the government's Universal Infant Free School Meal (UIFSM) system, it is still worth applying for FSM. Benefits of successful FSM applications are:

- A £100 uniform voucher (payable on your first successful application only).
- Free school milk up to the end of Year 2.
- Reduced costs for residential visits.
- Other benefits may become available from time to time.

If your child becomes eligible for Free School Meals before 31 March 2022, they will continue to be eligible until they leave Primary Education. This is regardless of any changes in your circumstances and means you do not need to tell us if your circumstances change.
