

This week

in EYFS we have been reading the story of The Enormous Turnip and in nursery we spent some time acting the story out. In maths the nursery children have been learning all about the number 4, finding four objects and counting to 4 in different ways such as clapping, jumping and stomping.

The Reception children have been looking at number patterns, learning their number bonds to 10 and counting in 2's and 5's. During our curriculum time we have spent a lot of time thinking about how we have grown and what we would all like to be when we grow up. The children had some great ideas and the Reception children did some fantastic independent writing. We have also spent time outside in the sunshine planting some of our own turnips and other vegetables such as broccoli and cauliflower, hopefully they will grow well and we can try them in the summer.

A great week well done EYFS.

This week in Year 1 the children have written their non-chronological reports on pollution. They remembered to include facts and linked their prior knowledge from science lessons. In Computing, the children focused on their typing skills, exploring the font style, font size and colour of their writing. The children have really enjoyed going into the ICT Suite. In PSHE, the children explored road safety and why it is important to cross the road safely. Keep up the hard work Year 1!

Year 2 have enjoyed learning about the last Tudor monarch, Elizabeth I. We have found learning about the Tudors really interesting this half term. In maths, we have been finding 1/2 and 1/4 of an amount. We have been practising dribbling and chest pass in PE. We evaluated our finished seascapes in art and are really proud of our Turner inspired art work.

LKS2

have had what feels like the busiest week so far! We have been working in mixed groups for maths as the year 3 children are learning all about mass and capacity and the year 4 children are learning about tenth and hundredths- Both groups are working exceptionally hard. In PE, the children are working on their dance routines and ensuring they have all the elements to make up a great sequence which they can't wait to perform next week. Beowulf is our new novel in English and we are finding out so much about the context of the first original poem which was written way back in the Anglo-Saxon times! It's been a great week and we can't wait to celebrate the successes in spring term next week.



This week, in UKS2, we have continued learning about biomes in science. We have looked in more detail about bio diversity and what might threaten it. In PE we have been making dance move freeze frames and putting them together in a routine to music. Next week we will finalise our routines and show them to the rest of the class, who will judge and critique our work. Class 10 have only one swimming lesson left and then it will be the rest of year 5's turn, they have done really well with most of them learning to swim. The weather has been lovely and the field has been dry enough to play on, it's been lovely to have the extra space, we even got to eat our packed lunches out there.

We are looking forward to our last week before a hard-earned rest! Have a lovely weekend and HAPPY MOTHER'S DAY to the lovely ladies in our lives.

Are you entitled to a £100 uniform voucher?

Am I entitled to free school meals

for my child?

Your child will be eligible for free school meals (FSM) if you are receiving one of the following benefits or support:

- Universal Credit Your annual net earned income must be no more that £7,400, as assessed by earnings from up to 3 of your most recent assessment periods.
- Income Support.
- Income-based Jobseeker's Allowance.
- Income-related ESA.
- Child Tax Credit but not Working Tax Credit and your annual income is below £16,190.
- Guarantee element of State Pension Credit.
- Support under part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999.
- Parents receiving Working Tax Credit for four weeks after their employment finishes are entitled to free school meals during that period. This also applies to parents who start working less than 16 hours per week.

You are NOT entitled to free school meals if:

• You receive Working Tax Credit except where the 'four week run-on' applies.

Even if your child is in Reception to Year 2 and they already receive a free meal under the government's Universal Infant Free School Meal (UIFSM) system, it is still worth applying for FSM. Benefits of successful FSM applications are:

- A £100 uniform voucher (payable on your first successful application only).
- Free school milk up to the end of Year 2.
- Reduced costs for residential visits.
- Other benefits may become available from time to time.

If your child becomes eligible for Free School Meals before 31 March 2022, they will continue to be eligible until they leave Primary Education. This is regardless of any changes in your circumstances and means you do not need to tell us if your circumstances change.




