In the interests of health and safety, we ask that children are supervised by parents/carers at all times at drop off and pick up times whilst on school premises.



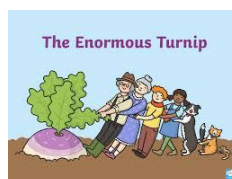

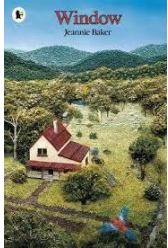
Should you wish to contact your child's class teacher you can do so by emailing the class email. However, this should not be used to report a child absent. All absence calls should be made to the school office.

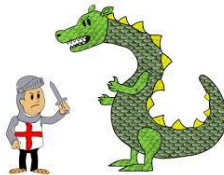


In Nursery we have continued to look at the story of The Enormous Turnip and in maths we have practised our number recognition for numbers up to 4 looking at the different ways these can be represented. In our phonics we have done lots of oral blending and practised our listening skills. The Reception pupils have been learning about Vincent Van Gogh and painted their own sunflower pictures. We have also read the story of Julia Donaldson's Money Puzzle and discussed the features of different animals. We have also been practising number bonds to 5. Excellent work Early Years!



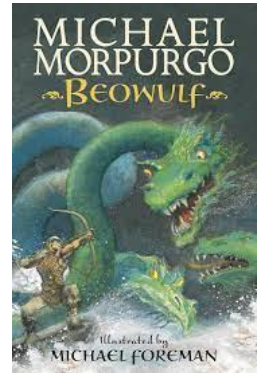


This week Year 1 have been writing their own poems based on our new class novel 'Window' by Jeannie Barker. The children have linked their English learning to their science learning on pollution and have enjoyed exploring the different views from a window. In Art, the children have drawn their version of a dragon from the story of 'George and the Dragon'. In Maths, the children have consolidated their knowledge on addition, place value within 20 and more than/less than. The children have really enjoyed using practical manipulatives - number lines, counters, cubes etc. Well done Year 1! Have a lovely Easter holiday!



Year 2 have been incredibly busy in this last week of term. It has been a week all about food. The children finished off their PHSE - A Healthy Me, making fruit skewers and learning what a healthy snack looks like. The RE unit this term has been celebrations and the story of Easter so this week, we have learned about the Seder Plate and the children tried some of the foods that Jewish people eat during Passover. Design Technology has been really enjoyable, as the children were very excited to learn that they would be designing and making their very own vegetarian pizza. Well done to the whole of Year 2 this week for showing such responsible, grown-up attitudes.

This week in LKS2 we have been continuing our decimals and mass learning in maths and we have learned so much this half term! We have finished our story of Beowulf and have really enjoyed creating freeze frames to summarise the plot. We have also enjoyed creating our illuminated letters in art, using paint in different ways to make our letters look like metal! We hope everyone had a safe Easter and practise their timetables!



This week in UKS2 we have been completing our History, Geography and Science ready to start new topics after Easter. In History we will be learning about WW1 and the impact it had not only in the UK but across Europe, In Science we will be learning about astronomy and in Geography we will be learning about New Zealand. Today, we have designed and made our own different types of bread, we added extra ingredients like olives, honey and herbs. Are you entitled?

Are you entitled to a £100 uniform voucher?

Am I entitled to free school meals

for my child?

Your child will be eligible for free school meals (FSM) if you are receiving one of the following benefits or support:

- Universal Credit - Your annual net earned income must be no more than £7,400, as assessed by earnings from up to 3 of your most recent assessment periods.
- Income Support.
- Income-based Jobseeker's Allowance.
- Income-related ESA.
- Child Tax Credit but not Working Tax Credit and your annual income is below £16,190.
- Guarantee element of State Pension Credit.
- Support under part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999.
- Parents receiving Working Tax Credit for four weeks after their employment finishes are entitled to free school meals during that period. This also applies to parents who start working less than 16 hours per week.

You are NOT entitled to free school meals if:

- You receive Working Tax Credit except where the 'four week run-on' applies.

Even if your child is in Reception to Year 2 and they already receive a free meal under the government's Universal Infant Free School Meal (UIFSM) system, it is still worth applying for FSM. Benefits of successful FSM applications are:

- A £100 uniform voucher (payable on your first successful application only).
- Free school milk up to the end of Year 2.
- Reduced costs for residential visits.
- Other benefits may become available from time to time.

If your child becomes eligible for Free School Meals before 31 March 2022, they will continue to be eligible until they leave Primary Education. This is regardless of any changes in your circumstances and means you do not need to tell us if your circumstances change.
