Health and Safety

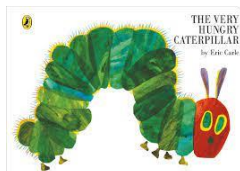
In the interests of health and safety, we ask that children are supervised by parents/carers at all times at drop off and pick up times whilst on school premises.

In Reception we have been learning to count in tens and ones in Maths using a tens frame. We have also started our new component 'Kings and Queens' by having a focus morning in which we



completed creative activities such as portrait painting and making our very own kings and queens. We have also continued talking about the different jobs there are within the NHS and Social Sector.



The Year 1 children have come back from Easter raring to go. We have been exploring multiplication in Maths, looking at equal groups as well as counting in

2's, 5's and 10's. In English, the children have started to look at our new class novel: One Day on our Blue Planet (in the Savannah) and have explored the key features of a narrative text. Our Geography unit this term is all about the UK. The children know how the Union Jack has been created by using elements from the English, Scottish and Irish flags. Keep up this positive attitude Year 1!



Year 2 have had a busy first week back. The children have come back well rested and eager to learn. We have enjoyed learning about what it's like to live in Scandinavia and can't wait to find out more about Northern Europe. We really enjoyed practising our throwing and batting skills in PE.



For LKS2 it has been a lovely start to summer term this week. The children have started to learn the rules of basketball in PE and have been dribbling and passing the ball.

In English, we have begun to read our class novel Alice in Wonderland. The children have been predicting what they think will happen and learning all about the author Lewis Carroll. We are looking forward to reading about the adventures of Alice.

Welcome back after a lovely Easter break. We had our raffle draw at the beginning of the week and had lots of lucky winners, congratulations to them all.

In UKS2 this week, we have started our new Science, History and Geography topics. In English we have been reading Silver Donkey by Sonya Hartnett, we will be basing our writing around this story, it also links to our History.

Are you entitled?

Are you entitled to a £100 uniform voucher?

Am I entitled to free school meals

for my child?

Your child will be eligible for free school meals (FSM) if you are receiving one of the following benefits or support:

- Universal Credit - Your annual net earned income must be no more than £7,400, as assessed by earnings from up to 3 of your most recent assessment periods.
- Income Support.
- Income-based Jobseeker's Allowance.
- Income-related ESA.
- Child Tax Credit but not Working Tax Credit and your annual income is below £16,190.
- Guarantee element of State Pension Credit.
- Support under part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999.
- Parents receiving Working Tax Credit for four weeks after their employment finishes are entitled to free school meals during that period. This also applies to parents who start working less than 16 hours per week.

You are NOT entitled to free school meals if:

- You receive Working Tax Credit except where the 'four week run-on' applies.

Even if your child is in Reception to Year 2 and they already receive a free meal under the government's Universal Infant Free School Meal (UIFSM) system, it is still worth applying for FSM. Benefits of successful FSM applications are:

- A £100 uniform voucher (payable on your first successful application only).
- Free school milk up to the end of Year 2.
- Reduced costs for residential visits.
- Other benefits may become available from time to time.

If your child becomes eligible for Free School Meals before 31 March 2022, they will continue to be eligible until they leave Primary Education. This is regardless of any changes in your circumstances and means you do not need to tell us if your circumstances change.
