For example:

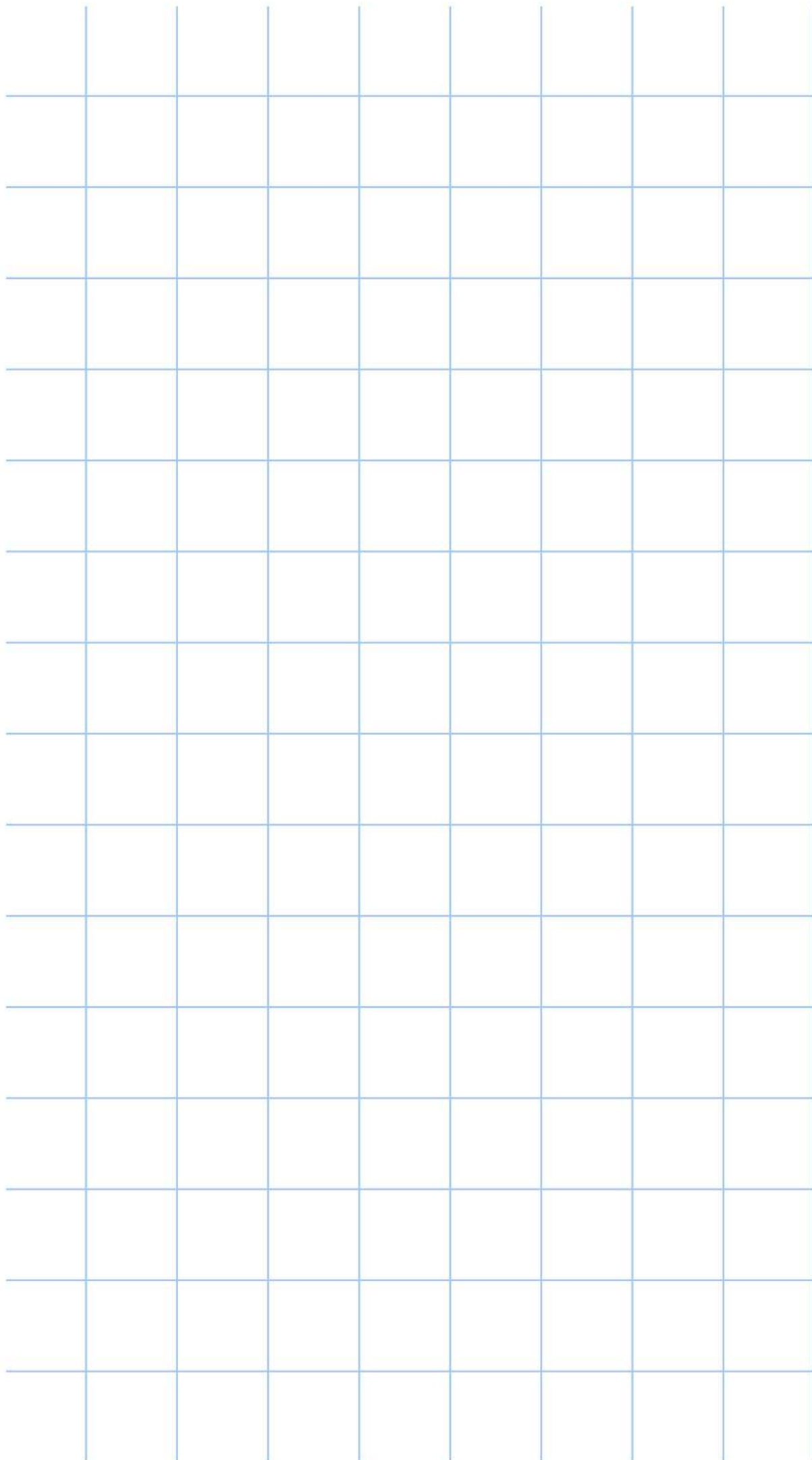
First there 4 cars in the carpark.
