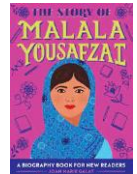


In Nursery this week, we have learnt about astronauts and space. The pupils have enjoyed creating their own space

pictures using chalk. In maths, the pupils have explored the concept of day and night plus daily routines. During phonics lessons, we have been practising blending and segmenting of sounds. The Reception pupils have begun to explore the new component 'Stories from the Past' by reading the traditional tale 'Little Red Riding Hood' in literacy. They have had the opportunity to retell the story and taken part in writing activities. In Maths, we have revisited number bonds to five such as $3+2=5$ and then begun to work with number bonds to ten. Well done for a fantastic week EYFS!



The first week back in Year 2 has flown by. The children have enjoyed starting all their new units of work. In English we began our new class novel 'Malala Yousafzai' and in Maths we have been out in the playground with metre sticks, learning to measure different objects. The children were really excited to start their science unit - astronomy, and they all did excellent diagrams of our solar system.



This week we have started our new novel, The Iron Man. We are enjoying finding out about the science-fiction character and are intrigued to find out what happens in this story. We are working really hard at statistics in maths and are producing some excellent tables and data! It has been an excellent first week back.



This week in English the children have been learning about Emmeline Pankhurst and are getting ready to write a fact file about her life. They have enjoyed learning about how people lived in the past and some really amazing questions and conversations have been had.



In maths the children have really enjoyed exploring money, they have been comparing coins and notes and adding them together to reach a total amount.

In science they have started a new unit of work on materials and have been exploring different properties and uses. Well done on a great week Year 1!

Welcome back, hope you all had a lovely half term. In UKS2 this week, we have had a lovely few days doing DT. Our brief was to create a pop-up book suitable for Year 1 children. We decided the theme would be nursery rhymes. We looked at lots of different mechanisms including pulleys, levers & flaps. We can't wait to show and read them to Year 1.



We have also introduced our new topics, science, we will study meteorology, history will be about The Suffragettes, geography will be about our local area, we are going to get the opportunity to ask one of our local councillors questions that affect our local community. Have a lovely weekend.



Are you entitled?

Are you entitled to a £100 uniform voucher?

Am I entitled to free school meals for my child?

Your child will be eligible for free school meals (FSM) if you are receiving one of the following benefits or support:

- Universal Credit - Your annual net earned income must be no more than £7,400, as assessed by earnings from up to 3 of your most recent assessment periods.
- Income Support.
- Income-based Jobseeker's Allowance.
- Income-related ESA.
- Child Tax Credit but not Working Tax Credit and your annual income is below £16,190.
- Guarantee element of State Pension Credit.
- Support under part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999.
- Parents receiving Working Tax Credit for four weeks after their employment finishes are entitled to free school meals during that period. This also applies to parents who start working less than 16 hours per week.

You are NOT entitled to free school meals if:

- You receive Working Tax Credit except where the 'four week run-on' applies.

Even if your child is in Reception to Year 2 and they already receive a free meal under the government's Universal Infant Free School Meal (UIFSM) system, it is still worth applying for FSM. Benefits of successful FSM applications are:

- A £100 uniform voucher (payable on your first successful application only).
- Free school milk up to the end of Year 2.
- Reduced costs for residential visits.
- Other benefits may become available from time to time.

If your child becomes eligible for Free School Meals before 31 March 2022, they will continue to be eligible until they leave Primary Education. This is regardless of any changes in your circumstances and means you do not need to tell us if your circumstances change.
