In Nursery this we have been learning all about numbers to 5 and practising our counting and problem solving skills. We have worked hard in phonics and practised writing our names. During our curriculum sessions, the Early Years pupils took part in our Ancient Greece WOW Day and really enjoyed trying some of the ancient Greek foods such as feta cheese, pitta bread and tzatziki. The teachers were proud of us trying new foods and talking about them. This week, we have also said goodbye to the EYFS butterflies in our garden area. All the pupils loved watching them fly up into the air. In Maths, Reception pupils have been counting beyond ten. They have worked hard to write menus for their own restaurants too! Well done for a fantastic week!



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Year 1 have enjoyed learning about Pinocchio this week. They made predictions about the story and decided whether they thought it was a fiction or non-fiction book. In maths, the children have started to learn about money. They are finding this very tricky! In PE, the children have been practicing for sports day. In Art, the children have made their own sculptures from pipe cleaners.



This week Year 2 have been working super hard as always! We have moved onto our new topic in English which is learning about space which goes very well with our science at the moment where the children are learning about planets and our solar system which they all seem to love! In maths we have moved onto statistics and looking at how to record data even recording our own charts in class based off our favourite pizza topping. Finally, the Year 2's like everyone in school thoroughly enjoyed the summer fayre and already can't wait for the next one.



This week has been a busy week for LKS2. We have been really busy completing our assessments, the children have done us really proud! In DT we have been using our plastic bottles to create our torches, following a design criteria and they look great. In science we have been continuing looking at circuits and now know all about Thomas Edison and the light bulb. In history we have carried on focusing on the Stuarts, during the reign of King Charles II - why don't you ask us what we know about the Great Plague and the fire of London.



This week in UKS2 we have been reading the Butterfly Lion, it is getting very sad. We have also been working on the project of a new theme park in Moorends, this has involved planning, finance and making of the park itself. Year 6, have also been making a moving buggy with Mr Francis from UTC.





Are you entitled to a £100 uniform voucher?

Am I entitled to free school meals for my child?

Your child will be eligible for free school meals (FSM) if you are receiving one of the following benefits or support:

- Universal Credit - Your annual net earned income must be no more than £7,400, as assessed by earnings from up to 3 of your most recent assessment periods.
- Income Support.
- Income-based Jobseeker's Allowance.
- Income-related ESA.
- Child Tax Credit but not Working Tax Credit and your annual income is below £16,190.
- Guarantee element of State Pension Credit.
- Support under part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999.
- Parents receiving Working Tax Credit for four weeks after their employment finishes are entitled to free school meals during that period. This also applies to parents who start working less than 16 hours per week.

You are NOT entitled to free school meals if:

- You receive Working Tax Credit except where the 'four week run-on' applies.

Even if your child is in Reception to Year 2 and they already receive a free meal under the government's Universal Infant Free School Meal (UIFSM) system, it is still worth applying for FSM. Benefits of successful FSM applications are:

- A £100 uniform voucher (payable on your first successful application only)
- Free school milk up to the end of Year 2.
- Reduced costs for residential visits.
- Other benefits may become available from time to time.

If your child becomes eligible for Free School Meals before 31 March 2022, they will continue to be eligible until they leave Primary Education. This is regardless of any changes in your circumstances and means you do not need to tell us if your circumstances change.

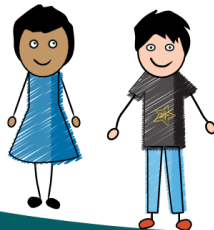
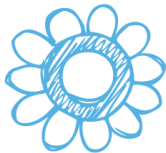
