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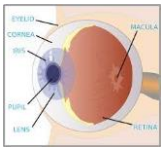




This week, in Reception, the pupils have been ordering the story of Goldilocks and the Three Bears. In Maths, they have been practising their sorting skills. We have been delighted to welcome in new starters to the Nursery class this week. We have been exploring the different areas of the provision including our newly equipped bike area in which we are learning about road safety. Well done Early Years!



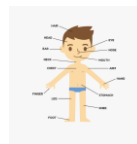
Year 1 have been continuing learning about Grandad's Island in English. In maths, they began looking at sequencing numbers, one more and one less, and counting backwards. In science, the children labelled the features of an eye using the scientific vocabulary. In art, the children have been learning about tints and shades, so they enjoying mixing colours.



This week in Year 2 during our geography sessions we have started to learn all about aerial views. We looked at an aerial view of our school and identified the different features we recognised. We have continued to read our book "The Treasure of Pirate Frank" and have learnt about nouns and adjectives, creating some fantastic expanded noun phrases. During our French sessions we have continued to learn different colours in practising saying these correctly and playing



games to help us remember them. In maths we are working on place value, identifying tens and ones and also writing numbers in words. In art we are continuing to learn about colour and shape and have spent time creating tints, adding small amounts of white to a colour to make it lighter. We enjoyed seeing many of the parents at our parents meeting and hope that it was useful for you. Another super week in Year 2.



Another amazing week in Year 3-4 with the children showcasing their skills in their independent writes where they described a Stone Age camp where some fantastic pieces of individual work was produced. Across other areas the children have also been excelling completing amazing work on maps in geography, the human body in science and starting the plan for our pneumatic toy in DT. Finally, to sum up our amazing week the children all took part in our Jeans for Genes day on Friday to help raise awareness for families who have been affected by genetic disorders.

Our third week in UKS2 has seen our students settle into their routines and start to excel in their learning. We have been continuing our dive into the magical world of 'The House with Chicken Legs' with our pupils focusing on the emotions of the characters to create diary entries. On Wednesday, it was World Fitness Day which got us all thinking about how to keep ourselves fit and healthy whilst also setting a fitness target to try to do every day for the next month.



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**Are you entitled to a £100 uniform voucher?**

**Am I entitled to free school meals for my child?**

**Your child will be eligible for free school meals (FSM) if you are receiving one of the following benefits or support:**

- Universal Credit - Your annual net earned income must be no more than £7,400, as assessed by earnings from up to 3 of your most recent assessment periods.
- Income Support.
- Income-based Jobseeker's Allowance.
- Income-related ESA.
- Child Tax Credit but not Working Tax Credit and your annual income is below £16,190.
- Guarantee element of State Pension Credit.
- Support under part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999.
- Parents receiving Working Tax Credit for four weeks after their employment finishes are entitled to free school meals during that period. This also applies to parents who start working less than 16 hours per week.

**You are NOT entitled to free school meals if:**

- You receive Working Tax Credit except where the 'four week run-on' applies.

Even if your child is in Reception to Year 2 and they already receive a free meal under the government's Universal Infant Free School Meal (UIFSM) system, it is still worth applying for FSM. Benefits of successful FSM applications are:

- A £100 uniform voucher (payable on your first successful application only)
- Free school milk up to the end of Year 2.
- Reduced costs for residential visits.
- Other benefits may become available from time to time.
- 

**If your child becomes eligible for Free School Meals before 31 March 2022, they will continue to be eligible until they leave Primary Education.** This is regardless of any changes in your circumstances and means you do not need to tell us if your circumstances change.

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

Plans are underway and we can confirm we will have the grotto, crafts tent and this year real reindeer all FOC. We are also hosting for the first time an indoor Christmas market. And have also arranged for a better selection of rides.

We are currently seeking sponsors which will determine how much other entertainment will can put on FOC. Road closure applications are currently with Doncaster Council and we await the outcome. The layout is being rethought and plans are in place to reduce crowding and improve safety around the stage area. A separate area will be cordoned off for performers. Full details of the layout will be confirmed once we have an outcome of the road closure applications.
