This week in Reception we have enjoyed continuing learning about our story 'The Wheels on the Tuk Tuk'. The children have completed sequencing

activities and had fun creating their own story maps. In maths, the children have been learning all about 4 and 5. In curriculum, we have been learning about different types of land transport across the world. In Nursery, the children have enjoyed continuing their learning about the story

'We're going on a bear hunt'. In maths, the children have been learning to compare shape and size. Well done EYFS for a fantastic week!







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Year 1 have had a brilliant week. They have been learning about non-chronological reports and are planning to write one about how to look after a star. This links to our class novel, My Pet

Star. In maths, the children have completed their addition and subtraction unit. We are so impressed by their understanding of numbers up to 20. In science, the children have been categorising animals based on what they eat.

Year 2 have had a brilliant week. They have thoroughly enjoyed learning about Diwali. You should have seen their dance moves on Monday while celebrating dancing with our visitor. This week we have started to learn about subtracting in maths. We would appreciate it if you could encourage your child to log into maths shed and times table rock stars to practice their maths skills further. In English, we have been learning about using apostrophes for possession, using our class text Issun Boshi. We have also thought about acts of kindness in PSHE and the meaning of the word dynamics in music.

Please remember to encourage your child to read at least 3 times a week and sign their diaries. Thanks.



Year 3-4 have had a busy week this week. We have been learning more about Ancient Egypt and found we're really interested to find out about how they built houses out of mud brick and used a hole in the ground as a refrigerator. We also learnt how the rich and poor members of Egyptian society lived and how their lives differed. In PE, we have been learning how to



play hockey! We practised holding the hockey stick with two hands and learnt how to dribble and pass the ball. We then had a whole class hockey game which was lots of fun!

This week in UKS2, our Year 6 children have worked so hard on their MOCK SATS and they have smashed their progress so far in autumn term- we are beyond proud! We have had an exceptional dancer in to



lead a session of Diwali dancing in the hall and we had so much fun, especially after our Hindu visitor's assembly last Thursday. For PSHE, we have been working to create a poster for a competition out of school to promote 'Antibullying' and have created our own hero to put a stop to bulling which ties in with Anti-bullying Week. What a great week we have had!

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#### **School Procedures for Absentees**

### First Day of Absence

The Attendance Officer will review registers on a daily basis, between 9am and 9.30am, noting any children absent without a reason being provided. At 9.30am the Attendance Officer (AO) will ring parent(s) on the contact list. If still they have not heard from the parent(s) or contacts on the list, the AO will send a text message to the parent(s) explaining if they do not contact the school within the next 30 minutes, to explain their child's absence, a home visit may well be conducted by the Designated Safeguarding Team.

If still the Designated Safeguarding Lead does not get a response from the parent(s) after a home visit, a home visit may well be conducted by the police. Any child on the Child Protection List, that is absent and we have received no explanation from a parent after ringing every contact on the contact list, will have a visit from the Designated Safeguarding Team. Should there be no response from the home visit, a call to Social Care and the Police will be made.

# Parents' Legal Responsibilities

Parents have a legal responsibility to ensure that their child/ren attend school and are responsible for the consequences of non-attendance.

Support will be offered. This will be communicated to parents through the school prospectus, Home/School Agreements, regular items on school newsletters and Friday letters. Meetings will be arranged with those parents whose child/ren have a pattern of absence or attendance falls below 95%.


These will all develop your understanding of parents' legal responsibilities along with involvement in the School Attendance Panel process where attendance shows no sign of improvements.





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
