This week in Reception we have enjoyed starting our new book 'Emma Jane's Aeroplane'. The children have made some fantastic predictions about what they think will happen in the story. In maths, the children have had

fun completing lots of exciting activities learning about 4 and 5. In curriculum, the children have been learning about transport in the past. In Nursery, the children have had fun continuing the story 'We're going on a Bear Hunt'. The children have completed lots of fun mark making activities in

provision. Nursery children have also enjoyed exploring the vehicle garage and pit-stop cafe in the outdoor provision. Well done EYFS for a super week!







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Year 1 are continuing to write their excellent non-chronological reports about how to care for pets. They are considering what pets



need to be healthy and using all of their phonics knowledge they have learned so far. This links to their science topic of animals. In maths, the children have completed their autumn assessments. We are so proud of the progress the children have made. They will be moving onto shape for their next topic, which will recap elements learned in reception as well as extend their knowledge. Miss Hartshorne and Miss Wilson are very excited to showcase the children's work at Parents Meetings.



Year 2 have had a great week. We have retold the story of Issun Boshi, the one inch boy using

conjunctions and extended noun phrases in English. We have also started to look at algorithms and coding in our computing lessons. The children can log into scratch at home for free and have a go at creating their own codes using inputs and outputs. We have created an inspiration board of Henri Matisse in art and learnt about his technique called 'painting with scissors.' Overall it has been another great week and we want to say thank you for continuing to read with your child.

Year 3-4 have been very busy this week! In history, the children learnt about Ancient Egyptian beliefs about death. It



was interesting to learn that people were laid to rest in tombs with all of their valuables in the belief that they would take them with them into the afterlife. In geography, we learnt the difference between rural, urban and suburban settlements. We also began learning about area in maths and the children gained a good understanding of what the area of a shape is and when we might need to calculate the area of a space in real life.



This week UKS2 have enjoyed learning all about road safety. We have made posters and gained a better understanding of

the laws that protect us on the roads. Our Year 5's have been working hard to complete their autumn assessments and we are so proud of their progress so far. In art we are continuing our research into Islamic architecture where we have been looking at different religious buildings across the world and finding out what makes them unique. Class 10 have been making amazing headway in their swimming and have all achieved certificates for their progress. Well done all.



#### **School Procedures for Absentees**

#### First Day of Absence

The Attendance Officer will review registers on a daily basis, between 9am and 9.30am, noting any children absent without a reason being provided. At 9.30am the Attendance Officer (AO) will ring parent(s) on the contact list. If still they have not heard from the parent(s) or contacts on the list, the AO will send a text message to the parent(s) explaining if they do not contact the school within the next 30 minutes, to explain their child's absence, a home visit may well be conducted by the Designated Safeguarding Team.

If still the Designated Safeguarding Lead does not get a response from the parent(s) after a home visit, a home visit may well be conducted by the police. Any child on the Child Protection List, that is absent and we have received no explanation from a parent after ringing every contact on the contact list, will have a visit from the Designated Safeguarding Team. Should there be no response from the home visit, a call to Social Care and the Police will be made.

#### Parents' Legal Responsibilities

Parents have a legal responsibility to ensure that their child/ren attend school and are responsible for the consequences of non-attendance.

Support will be offered. This will be communicated to parents through the school prospectus, Home/School Agreements, regular items on school newsletters and Friday letters. Meetings will be arranged with those parents whose child/ren have a pattern of absence or attendance falls below 95%.


These will all develop your understanding of parents' legal responsibilities along with involvement in the School Attendance Panel process where attendance shows no sign of improvements.
